

## **IN CASE YOU MISSED IT Survey Shows Nearly 2/3rd of California Voters Oppose Internet Poker**

Sacramento, Calif. --- While there may be discussions within Sacramento about internet poker, it is clear that voters do not support it. In a survey done in June 2013, 63 percent of California voters oppose legalizing internet poker. Californians do not view internet poker the same as other gambling operations in the state and are concerned about potential abuses and problems with it.

Key facts include:

- Majority of voters in every region of the state oppose legalizing internet poker.
- Majority of voters among every political affiliation – Republican, Democrat, and Independent/Decline to State oppose legalizing internet poker.
- Majority of voters among high propensity voters like seniors, union households, and those who attend church services weekly oppose legalizing internet poker.
